DESCRIPTION OF THE PARTIES

Time Warner Cable Information Systems (Ohio), LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable

Time Warner Cable Information Services (Ohio), LLC (TWCIS), is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Time Warner Cable, Inc. (Time Warner Cable). TWCIS is a Delaware limited liability company authorized to do business in Ohio as a foreign limited liability company. By means of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, Certificate No. 90-9278, issued in Commission Case No. 05-837-TP-ACE on August 1, 2005, TWCIS is authorized in Ohio to provide local exchange services and interexchange services in Ohio. TWCIS is a non-BLES competitive local exchange carrier which provides local and interexchange services, including high capacity transmission services, to customers.

Time Warner Cable is a publicly traded Delaware corporation with its headquarters located at 60 Columbus Circle, New York, New York 10023. It is a leading provider of video, high-speed data, and voice services to residential and business customers in the United States. Time Warner's Cable network facilities cover portions of 31 states, including Ohio.

Comcast Corporation

Comcast Corporation (Comcast) is a publicly traded corporation organized under the laws of Pennsylvania. Its principal offices are located at One Comcast Center, Philadelphia, PA 19103-2838. Comcast is a global media and technology company with network facilities covering portions of 39 states and the District of Columbia. Comcast is a leading provider of video, high-speed Internet, digital voice, and other next-generation services and technologies to residential customers and small- and medium-sized businesses. Having consistently invented, developed, deployed, and improved a wide range of new technologies and services, Comcast has established a reputation as an industry leader in communications, technology, financial performance, and operational efficiency.

Through its subsidiaries, Comcast currently provides voice services to approximately 10.85 million customers, including residential and business subscribers. Using VoIP technology, Comcast provides competitive facilities-based voice services to deliver digital-quality phone service, plus enhanced features that are integrated with other Comcast services.

To the extent relevant to the instant application, one Comcast subsidiary, Comcast Phone of Ohio, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone d/b/a CIMCO, a Division of Comcast Business Services (Comcast Phone of Ohio) is currently authorized to provide competitive local exchange services in certain telephone exchanges in Ohio, and provide competitive telecommunication services throughout Ohio.¹ Comcast Phone of Ohio is a separately operated subsidiary of Comcast and will continue to operate as such. The transaction will not create a diminishment of competition as Comcast Phone of Ohio and TWCIS operate in different exchanges in Ohio.²

EXHIBIT D

DESCRIPTION OF AND RATIONALE FOR THE INVOLVED TRANSACTION, INCLUDING PUBLIC INTEREST CONSIDERATIONS

On February 12, 2014, Comcast entered into an agreement with Time Warner Cable to acquire 100 percent of Time Warner Cable's equity in exchange for Comcast Class A shares (CMCSA). The proposed transaction is a straightforward acquisition of Time Warner Cable. As illustrated in the pre- and post-merger structure charts attached immediately following this description, at the closing of the transaction, Tango Acquisition Sub, Inc. (Merger Sub), a new direct wholly owned subsidiary of Comcast, will merge with Time Warner Cable under Delaware law. At that time, the separate corporate existence of Merger Sub will cease, and, thereafter, Time Warner Cable will be a wholly owned subsidiary of Comcast. Contemporaneously with the merger, each Time Warner cable share will be converted into the right to receive 2.875 shares of CMCSA.

Upon completion of the transaction, TWCIS will become an indirect, wholly owned subsidiary of Comcast.³ See attached corporate structure diagrams. This Application does not seek authority for the transfer of customers or for any changes in rates, terms, or conditions of service.⁴ It is therefore anticipated that the change in ownership of the TWCIS will be seamless. TWCIS customers will still take service from TWCIS after the completion of the transaction. Given that customers will not be affected by the transaction, customer notice is not required.

Comcast is a financially strong, publicly traded corporation that is well positioned to effectively manage the TWCIS in Ohio. In 2013, Comcast saw an increase in consolidated revenue of 3.3 percent to \$64.7 billion and an increase in consolidated operating income of 11.4 percent to \$13.6 billion; revenues from voice services increased 2.8 percent to \$3.6 billion.⁵

Comcast also has expert technological and service capabilities as a communications provider. Comcast's experience includes an array of communications of broadband service, including local and long distance voice (using VoIP technology), broadband data and video, and a host of advance technology and other service offerings. Moreover, Comcast invests heavily in network infrastructure in its markets—exceeding tens of billions since 1996—to provide a robust network for today's needs that is capable of evolving to meet tomorrow's consumer and business demands.

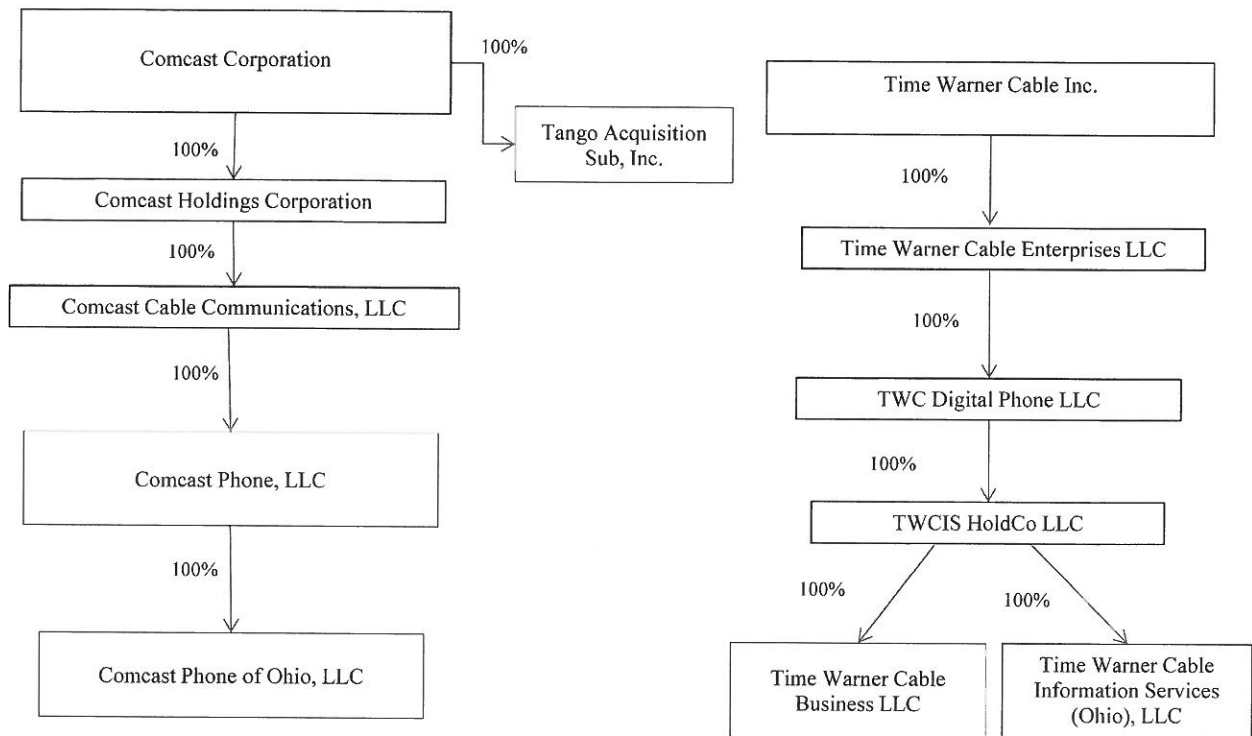
The proposed transaction will generate substantial public interest benefits with no countervailing harms. TWCIS will continue to offer competitive services in Ohio at the same rates and pursuant to the same terms following consummation of the transaction.⁷ The transaction will promote the deployment of advanced interexchange services and high capacity transmission services. By permitting Comcast and Time Warner Cable to combine the best aspects of their robust and innovative communications services, approval of this transaction will leave the merged company even better suited to offer an array of advanced voice services in competition with other similarly situated providers.

Approval of this transaction will provide communications customers in Ohio with a more robust competitor in the marketplace, leading to improved services and choices for consumers. Further, businesses of all sizes in Ohio will benefit from a substantial increase in much-needed competition and the accelerated deployment of advanced services. The transaction will produce significant public interest benefits by creating a combined company with a larger overall national footprint that can actively compete in the business sector to fulfill customers' integrated communication needs.

Post-Transaction Structure - Ohio

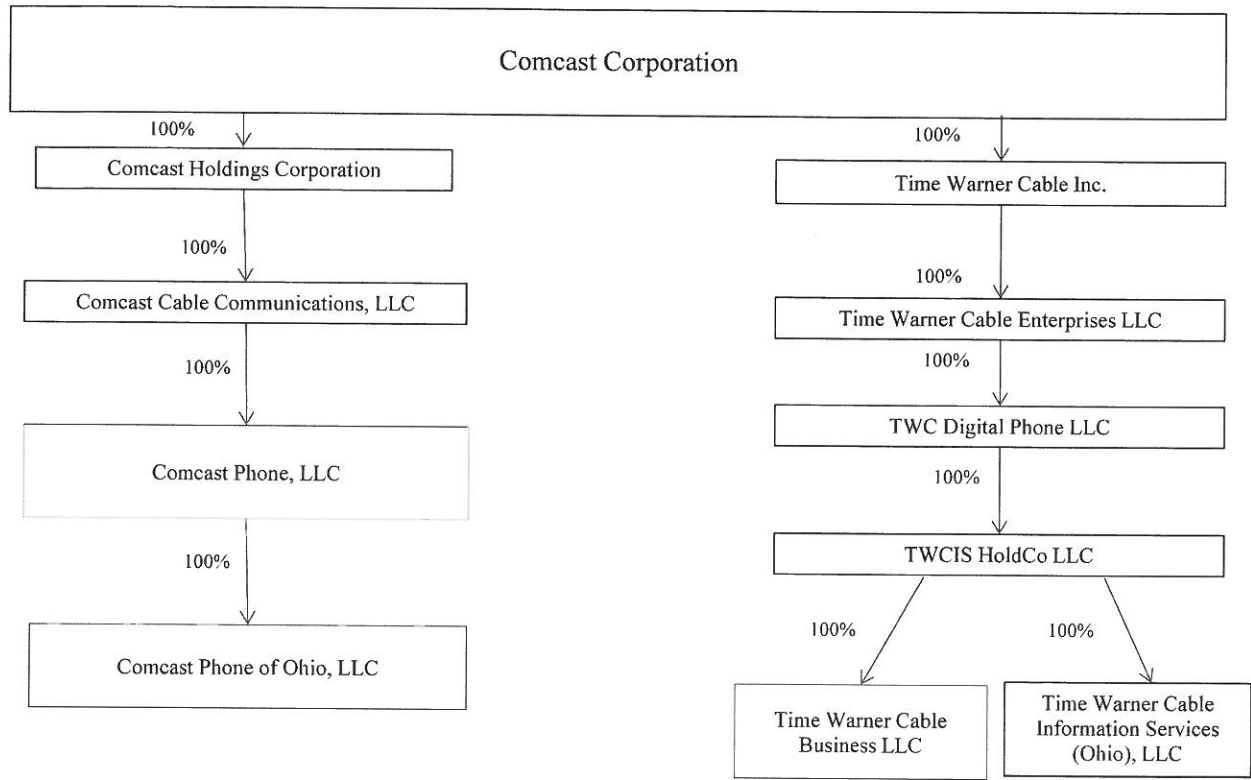
