FINDING AND ORDER

The Commission finds:

- (1) On July 18, 2012, the Commission issued the Opinion and Order in In re Ohio Edison Co, Cleveland Elec. Illum. Co., and Toledo Edison Co. for Auth. to Provide for a Std. Serv. Offer Pursuant to R.C. 4928.143, Revised Code, in the Form of an Elec. Security Plan, Case No. 12-1230-EL-SSO (ESP III Case). In that Opinion and Order, the Commission found that Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy or the Companies) should file annually applications for the review of the Companies' Generation Service Rider (Rider GEN).
- (2) On May 1, 2014, the Companies filed applications for the review of Rider GEN, as well as tariffs to reflect changes to Rider GEN, which are scheduled to take place automatically on June 1, 2014. Thereafter, on May 16, 2014, the Companies filed revised tariff pages reflecting corrections to Rider GEN, which were previously filed in error.
- (3) Thereafter, on May 20, 2014, the Commission's Staff filed comments on the Companies' applications. In its comments, Staff states that it performed an audit of the revised tariff pages presented by the Companies and finds the submitted revised tariff pages and tariff rates for Rider GEN to be supported by adequate data and properly allocated. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the applications.

(4) The Commission has reviewed the Companies' applications and Staff's review and recommendations and finds that the revised tariffs are consistent with our Opinion and Order in the *ESP III Case* and do not appear to be unjust and unreasonable. Therefore, we adopt Staff's recommendations and approve the Companies' applications.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That FirstEnergy's applications be approved. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Finding and Order be served upon all parties of record in this proceeding.
