**MOTION FOR PERMISSION TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE**

Pursuant to Rule 4901-1-08(B) of the Ohio Administrative Code and Rule XII (2)(A)(6) of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio, the undersigned, an Ohio attorney, respectfully moves that William Massey be admitted *pro hac vice* to practice before the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio for the purpose of representing Accenture LLP in the instant matter. In support thereof, the undersigned states as follows:

G. The Ohio Supreme Court has issued PHV #1770-2014 to Mr. Massey.



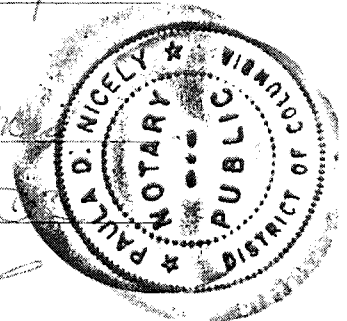


