## Rex Energy seeking assistance from county, CIC to complete waterline project

Rex Energy officials visited Carroll County Commissioners Monday asking for assistance with a water line proposed to run along the edge of county and Community Improvement Corp (CIC) owned property at the Commercial Park.

Senior Land Agent Matt Mathewy said the line will connect the Jenkins farm with Carroll One Farm land located along SR 11 and be about 5,000 feet in length. Mathewy said a 50-foot right of way will be necessary during construction but after that, only 30 or even 25 feet of right of way will be required when construction is finished.

The 12-inch water line will be buried 48 inches deep and will be a direct north-south route, according to Mathewy. The line is coming from Solonville.

Commissioner Tim Wheaton asked what the land would be used for following installation. Mathewy said he will check for specific details on use on the buildings will be permitted. A gravel parking lot would probably be acceptable but not a paved one.

Wheaton said the land will total about 4 1/2 acres. Mathewy offered a payment of \$18 per foot

but said that could be increased to \$20 per foot.

He said the county would receive compensation for trees removed or crops which are disturbed. Mathewy will seek approval from the commissioners (questions and answers to email to [carroll@carrollcountyoil.com](mailto:carroll@carrollcountyoil.com)).

Development Director Aaron Dodds and Ralph Castellucci, at the request of Dodds to discuss confidential information. No outcome was reported.

MET in executive session with Maintenance Supervisor Ed Eick to discuss the appointment of an employee for the new courthouse roof project and to finish up information for the bidding process.

ANNOUNCED Dale Hartle will attend the May 22 commission meeting to discuss specifics for the new courthouse roof project and to finish up information for the bidding process. Commissioners hired Hartle's firm, Ohio Regional Development Corp., to provide consulting services for the courthouse roof replacement project last week at a cost of \$85,000.

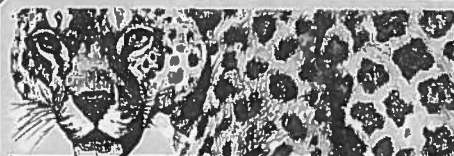
APPROVED a three year contract with Exact Two Wash, Inc. of Carroll to clean vents in the jail kitchen. The fire marshal said they have to be done twice a year to meet state standards. The contract will cost \$275 per year for the cleanings.

APPROVED a division order with Chesapeake Operating Inc. for the Walters well in Perry Dep. The order allows commissioners to receive royalty payments from the well.

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### CIC From A-1

Commissioner Tim Wheaton asked about the possibility of bringing in a real estate broker on a commission basis to assist with development of the Commerce Park.

He ruled an outside developer is interested in helping to improve the village and Commerce Park.

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AFP Ohio Transmission Company (AFP Ohio) has proposed to construct a new 138 kV line, 138 kV transmission line, in Loudon and Perry townships in Carroll County.

The purpose of the Kilgore Pole Road 138 kV Transmission Line Project is to provide electricity to Access Motors/Kilgore. The project will build the new line using approximately 11 standard single circuit steel H frame 138 kV structures. The Kilgore Pole Road 138 kV transmission line will be approximately two miles long. This project will be an approximately \$5 million investment by AFP Ohio. Construction is scheduled to commence in July 2014.

The project is known as the Kilgore Pole Road 138 kV Transmission Line Project. As required by Ohio Revised Code Section 4906.11 (G) AFP Ohio has filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board, under Case No. 14-0787-EL-BLN. This number should be included in all communications with respect to this proceeding.

This project meets the requirements for a Letter of Notification because it is within the types of projects defined by item (1)(G) of Attachment A of the interim process defined in the OPSB's Sept. 4, 2012, Finding and Order in Docket 12-180 (6-890). This states that a project qualifies for a Letter of Notification if the project is:

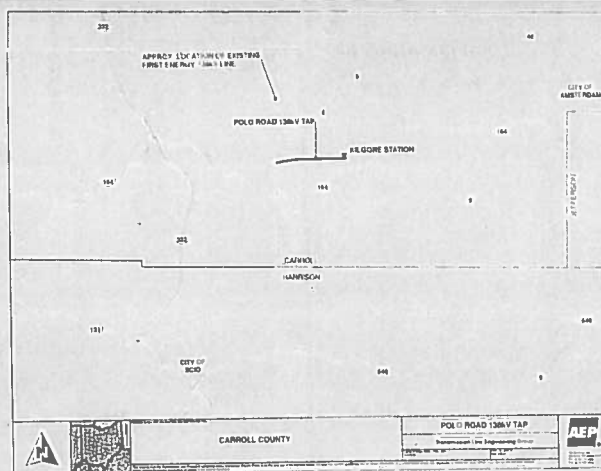
- (1) Rerouting, extension or new construction of single or multiple circuit electric transmission lines;
- (2) Primarily needed to meet the requirements of a specific customer.

Petitions to intervene in or comment on the Letter of Notification will be accepted by the siting board up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice required by Rule 4306.5-08(C)(1), OAC. Petitions should be submitted to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and must cite Case No. 14-0787-EL-BLN.

The accompanying map depicts the project area. It should be noted that due to the proposed scale and limited detail, this map should be used only as a general guide.
