Dear Ms. McNeal:

On March 17, 2014, the Ohio Power Siting Board ("Board") issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need subject to a number of conditions.

Condition No. 21 of the Board's Order requires the following:

Prior to the commencement of construction activities that require permits, licenses, or authorizations by federal or state laws and regulations, Vectren shall obtain and comply with such permits, licenses, or authorizations. Vectren shall provide copies of permits and authorizations, including all supporting documentation, to Staff within seven days of issuance or receipt by the Applicant. Vectren shall provide a schedule of construction activities and acquisition of corresponding permits for each activity at the preconstruction conference.

In compliance with Condition No. 21 of the Board's Opinion, Order, and Certificate, attached for filing is a copy of the letter from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources accepting Vectren's preliminary plans for the directional drilling for the pipeline crossing under the detention dam embankment.

On May 15, 2014, the Ohio Dam Safety Program received a copy of preliminary directional drilling plans and subsurface investigation conducted by Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc. and Geotechnical Consultants Inc. for Dayton Airport Detention Pond Dam dated May 12, 2014. The report studied horizontal direction drilling of a 12-inch natural gas transmission pipeline under the dam embankment. We have completed our review of the investigation and preliminary plans, and it appears that the submitted course of action is acceptable.

It appears that the directional drilling would be well below the base of the constructed dam embankment and would not impact the dam, as concluded in the submitted report. Additional design information, plans, and specifications are not required by the Division of Soil and Water Resources for review or approval.
