The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On June 13, 2014, DP&L filed an application for authority to sell its East Bend Unit 2 (East Bend) generation asset. In its application, DP&L requests that the Commission initiate expedited proceedings, including waiver of any otherwise applicable public or evidentiary hearing process, and establish an accelerated procedural schedule with a comment and reply comment period.
- (3) In order to assist the Commission in its review of DP&L's application, the following procedural schedule should be established:
 - (a) July 18, 2014 Deadline for the filing of comments/objections to the application by Staff and interveners.
 - (b) August 1, 2014 Deadline for all parties to file reply comments.
- (4) After comments and reply comments are received and the issues raised therein considered, the Commission will make a decision regarding DP&L's application and its request for waiver of any hearing requirement in this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the procedural schedule set forth in finding (3) be adopted. It is, further,
