Dear Ms. McNeal:

The Federal Communications Commission's November 18, 2011 USF/ICC Transformation Order, FCC 11-161 (WC Docket No. 10-90) ("Order") established certain transitional access service requirements. AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") is implementing the Step 3 Transitional Access Service requirements of the Order. In Step 3, terminating switched end office and reciprocal compensation rates are reduced by one-third of the differential between end office rates and \$0.0007. The intrastate terminating end office switched access and reciprocal compensation rates are then set to parity with the terminating end office rates that will become effective July 31, 2014 in AT&T Corp. Tariff FCC No. 2.
