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THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has scheduled at this time and place a hearing in Case No. 14-213-GA-GCR, being In the Matter of the Regulation of the Purchased Gas Adjustment Clauses Contained within the Rate Schedules of Piedmont Gas Company and Related Matters.

This hearing is also being held concerning Case No. 14-313-GA-UEX, In the Matter of Uncollectible Expense Rider of Piedmont Gas Company and Related Matters.

I am Jim Lynn, the attorney-examiner assigned to preside over this hearing. At this time I request the parties enter an appearance on the record.

Good morning, your Honor. MR. LINDGREN: On behalf of the staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, Attorney General Mike DeWine, by Thomas G. Lindgren, assistant attorney general, 180 East Broad Street, Sixth Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: All right. you. I see no one else here who is making an

5 appearance in the proceeding. At this point we will 1 2 go forward, Mr. Lindgren. 3 MR. LINDGREN: Thank you. First, your 4 Honor, I wanted to report for the record that the parties have reached a Stipulation and Recommendation 5 that we have marked as Joint Exhibit 1, and I would 6 7 like to offer that at this time. 8 THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: All right. Thank 9 you. 10 (EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.) MR. LINDGREN: Next the staff would like 11 12 to call Roger Sarver to the stand. 13 THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Mr. Sarver, if 14 you would come up here to the witness stand. 15 16 ROGER SARVER 17 being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was examined and testified as follows: 18 19 DIRECT EXAMINATION 2.0 By Mr. Lindgren: 2.1 Good morning, Mr. Sarver. Ο. 22 Good morning. Α. Mr. Sarver, where are you employed? 23 Q.

> Q. What is your business address?

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Α.

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

- A. 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
  - Q. What are your duties with the Public Utilities Commission?
  - A. I oversee the gas financial audits of the gas cost recovery mechanism, the uncollectible riders, along with the PIPP rider, Percentage of Income Payment Plan.
  - Q. And are you familiar with the facts of the proceeding that we are here on this morning?
    - A. Yes, sir.

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- Q. Thank you. And were you involved in the audit of the Purchased Gas Adjustment Clause of the Piedmont Gas Company?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Thank you.

  (EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)
- Q. I would like you to look at what I have marked as Commission-ordered Exhibit 1. Do you recognize this document.
  - A. Yes, sir, I do.
  - Q. And can you explain what it is?
- A. This is the Gas Cost Recovery Audit of Piedmont Gas Company. The report was filed April 18, 2014, and it covers the period of December 1, 2011

through November 30, 2013.

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- Q. Does the document accurately reflect the results of the audit performed by the staff?
  - A. Yes, sir.

(EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)

- Q. Thank you. I would also ask you to examine the document that I have marked as Commission-Ordered Exhibit 2. Mr. Sarver, do you recognize this document?
  - A. Yes, sir, I do.
  - Q. And can you explain what it is?
- A. This is the audit of the Uncollectible Expense Rider for Piedmont Gas Company for the period of January 2012 through December 2013. This report was filed on April 18, 2014.
- Q. Thank you. And does the report accurately reflect the results of the audit performed by the staff?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Thank you. Mr. Sarver, I would like to direct your attention to the document that has been marked as Joint Exhibit 1. Do you recognize the document?
  - A. Yes, sir, I do.
- Q. And what is it?

- A. Joint Exhibit 1 is the Stipulation and Recommendation entered into by staff and Piedmont to resolve the recommendations and issues found in the gas cost recovery audit in Case No. 14-213-GA-GCR, along with the recommendations and issues identified in the staff audit of Piedmont's Uncollectible Expense Rider in Case No. 14-313-GA-UEX.
- Q. Thank you. And are you familiar with the terms of this Stipulation and Recommendation?
  - A. Yes, sir.

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- Q. Thank you. And were you also involved in the negotiation of these terms?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Thank you. Mr. Sarver, in your opinion is this settlement the product of serious bargaining among capable and knowledgeable parties?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. And does this settlement, as a package, benefit both ratepayers and the public interest?
- A. Yes, sir, it does. The audits were conducted to ensure that the company accurately calculated its gas cost recovery mechanism, along with its uncollectible expense rider, and to ensure that it was properly applied to customers' bills.

The findings of the audits, other than

the recommendations, shows that the company accurately calculated its rates and applied it to customers' bills.

- Q. Thank you. Mr. Sarver, are you familiar with the regulatory principles and practices that apply in this type of proceeding?
  - A. Yes, sir.

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- Q. And does this settlement package violate any important regulatory principle or practice?
  - A. Not to my knowledge.
- Q. Thank you. Would you recommend that the Commission adopt the Stipulation and Recommendation?
  - A. Yes, I would.

MR. LINDGREN: Thank you. I have no further questions for this witness.

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## EXAMINATION

By The Attorney Examiner:

- Q. Mr. Sarver, were you among the parties who worked with Rick Mako, M-A-K-O?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. And are you familiar with him from having worked on other cases in the past?
  - A. Since about 1988.
  - Q. So you are quite familiar with these

matters?

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A. Yes. Rick and his wife, Joan, formed Piedmont back in the late '80s. When we first started doing these gas cost recovery audits, we used to do them in their dining room, so, yes, we worked with the company for over 20 years on the audits.

THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: All right. Thank you. I have no further questions.

Could we go off the record for a minute, please.

(Discussion off record.)

THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: I also note that there is no one else here to testify, so

Mr. Lindgren, anything else from your perspective?

MR. LINDGREN: Well, I just want to note for the record the proof of publication has been

filed in the docket for this case, and that is noted in the Stipulation and Recommendation.

THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you.

Having said that, I'll note that for the record we will mark the exhibits as you indicated.

The Stipulation and Recommendation is Joint Exhibit 1.

The audit for the Gas Cost Recovery is Commission-ordered Exhibit 1.
