On August 28, 2013, in the above referenced case, the Commission issued its Finding and Order ("Order") which approved and adopted the August 4, 2013 settlement agreement between Commission Staff ("Staff") and Ozark Motor Lines ("Respondent"). A term included and approved in that Order required Staff to re-compute the civil forfeiture at this time, based on Respondent's recent history factor, and recommend whether Respondent should pay any of the remaining civil forfeiture held in abeyance. The Staff reports that Respondent's recent history factor is a 1 and recommends that no additional civil forfeiture be assessed against the Respondent.
