

On 03/11/2014, a vehicle operated by ALL STATES TRANSPORTATION LLC, and driven by MAURICIO LEIVA, was inspected within the State of Ohio. Such failure shall also constitute a waiver of your right to further contest liability to the state of Ohio for the civil forfeiture described in the notice and will result in the forfeiture amount being referred to the Ohio Attorney General's office for collection.
