AT&T Ohio proposes to modify its AT&T Tariff P.U.C.O. No. 20, Part 21, Section 2, Access Services, in order to correct/update certain outdated information as follows:

Sheet 1:

Intrastate switched access rates mirror the interstate rates. The rates here are zero and serve no purpose; as such they are being removed.

Sheet 4:

The errors in certain paragraph section references are being corrected to reflect the correct paragraphs being referenced.

References to P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 20, Part 9, Sections 1 and 3 are being replaced with references to the AT&T Ohio Guidebook.

Sheet 13:

Letter "L" referred to the AT&T Volume Discount Plan (AVDP) which was sunset from the federal tariff a few years ago and so, this exception is no longer needed.

Letter "M" referred to the Merger 6 Commitment associated with the AT&T/BellSouth merger. That exception no longer applies and is being removed.

Letter "N" removes the reference to the filing of contracts with the PUCO which is no longer required.

None of these changes is customer impacting and so, no customer notice is required.
