Project Description

This project involves the construction of approximately 234 feet of 138 kilovolt (kV) transmission line. The Applicant's proposed line would provide a tap source for a planned American Electric Power transmission line that received Ohio Power Siting Board approval on June 19, 2014 (ref: 14-0787-EL-BLN).

Site Description

The Applicant has obtained easements for all necessary right-of-way. As part of American Electric Power's application, the entire corridor was studied for ecological resources. There are no streams or wetlands within the right-of-way of this project. Any required clearing activities have been previously approved by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service. The surrounding land use is agricultural.

Conclusion

Access is readily available for construction. The construction of this project should pose only minimal negative social and ecological impacts.
