**JOINT MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY SOLUTIONS CORP. AND THE TIMKEN
COMPANY, ET AL., FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO RESPOND TO MOTIONS FILED ON JULY 17, 2014
(EXPEDITED RULING REQUESTED)**

In accordance with Ohio Adm. Code 4901-1-12 and 4901-1-13, FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. (FES) and The Timken Company, Marathon Petroleum Company, Wausau Paper Towel and Tissue LLC, ASHTA Chemicals Inc., Columbus Castings, The Lincoln Electric Company, Delphi Corporation, and Landmark Plastic Corporation (collectively, Industrial Customers) jointly request a three-day extension of time for FES to respond to the Industrial Customers' July 17, 2014 Motion to Intervene and Motion for Interim and Preliminary Orders (collectively, the July 17 Motions).

The current response date for the July 17 Motions is August 1, 2014. The deadline for filing an answer in this case is August 4, 2014. Responses to a different set of motions filed by the Industrial Customers are also due on August 4, 2014. FES and the Industrial Customers have agreed that for purposes of efficiency and avoidance of duplicative filings, the response date for

the July 17 Motions should be extended to August 4, 2014. If Industrial Customers elect to file a reply, it would be due on August 11, 2014.

FES and the Industrial Customers also request expedited treatment of this motion in accordance with Ohio Adm. Code 4901-1-12(C). Because this request is for an extension of time for less than five days, an immediate ruling may be issued without the filing of responsive memoranda.

For the foregoing reasons, FES and the Industrial Customers respectfully request that the Commission grant this motion and extend the response date for the July 17 Motions to August 4, 2014.
