The deponent(s) is required to attend from day-to-day until the deposition(s) is completed. Such person(s) will be deposed and will be subject to cross examination by the Ohio Consumers' Counsel in the proceeding entitled "In the Matter of the Application of Duke Energy Ohio for Authority to Establish a Standard Service Offer Pursuant to Section 4928.143, Revised Code, in the Form of an Electric Security Plan, Accounting Modifications and Tariffs for Generation Service."
