
MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

The City of Rittman ("Rittman") was issued Certificate No. 04-117E(5) which authorizes it to provide electricity to its constituents as an Ohio government aggregator for the two-year period commencing July 23, 2012 and ending July 23, 2014. Unfortunately, due to an inadvertent administrative error, Rittman failed to file its renewal application by the filing deadline of June 23, 2014. The Commission will receive a filed copy of Rittman's 2014 renewal application by August 30, 2014. There have been no material changes in Rittman's business practices as defined in Rule 4901:1-1-24-10 of the Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC").

Rittman respectfully requests that the Commission extend Certificate No. 04-117E(5) to September 30, 2014. Rittman apologizes for this administrative oversight and pledges that all reports and certifications required by the Commission will be timely filed in the future.

The Commission has plenary authority to extend the expiration date of Rittman's certificate for good cause shown. As demonstrated above, Rittman's tardiness in filing its Renewal Application was solely due to an inadvertent administrative error. Moreover, Rittman's business practices have not changed in any material respect since its last certification was filed in 2012. Consequently, Rittman respectfully requests an extension of the expiration date of its certification.
