MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

On July 23, 2012, in Case No. 12-1854-EL-AGG, the Commission issued Certificate Number 12-537E(1), which certified Trebel as a competitive retail electric service aggregator/power broker. By its terms, the certificate expired on July 19, 2014. Unfortunately, due to an inadvertent oversight, a renewal application to extend the effectiveness of the certificate was not timely filed.
