

**APPLICATION OF FIBERNET OF OHIO, LLC TO

FiberNet of Ohio, LLC, (“FiberNet” or “Applicant”), through its attorney, hereby respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (“PUCO”) grant this Application to withdraw the continued provision of unbundled network element based telecommunications services in the Ironton, Ohio local exchange area of effective November 3, 2014. In support of said Application, FiberNet represents the following:

2. FiberNet of Ohio, LLC (“FiberNet”), is a facilities-based CLEC authorized by the PUCO to provide competitive telecommunications services in select markets within the current AT&T and Frontier North ILEC service areas in Ohio through PUCO Certificate No. 90-9201.

3. Prior to the instant filing, FiberNet has been a party to two regulatory proceedings before the PUCO involving corporate ownership and restructuring issues. In Case No. 10-1063-TP-ACO, the PUCO authorized a change in control of FiberNet from One Communications Corporation to NTELOS Holdings (“NTELOS”).
4. Thereafter, in Case No. 11-2324-TA-ACO, the PUCO approved a plan proposed by NTELOS to create separate wireless and wireline businesses by spinning off the wireline business into a separate, publicly traded company. This particular transaction was finalized on or about November 1, 2011, and as a result, the corporate wireline business unit, which includes FiberNet of Ohio, LLC, was rebranded as Lumos Networks.
5. Although the corporate wireline business unit was rebranded as Lumos Networks as noted above, the corporate name of FiberNet of Ohio, LLC has not yet been changed, and as a result, FiberNet continues to operate as a CLEC in Ohio under its certificated name: FiberNet of Ohio, LLC.
6. Although primarily a facilities-based provider of telecommunications services utilizing a state-of-the-art fiber optic network, FiberNet must still rely upon wholesale unbundled network elements (“UNEs”) leased from the ILEC and provisioned through physical collocation arrangements established in the ILEC central office in order to deliver service to certain end user customers. In order for Lumos’ business to be successful, and for its customers to receive quality service in situations such as this in which a fiber optic based market solution is not feasible, these leased UNEs must not only be reliable, but must also be priced, maintained, and if necessary, repaired by the ILEC in a timely and commercially reasonable manner. Because of the operational and business challenges inherent in the use of UNEs leased from the ILEC, FiberNet seeks to build fiber optic facilities to its customers’ premises whenever feasible thereby replacing the ILEC UNEs with Lumos’ own facilities.
7. As of the time of this filing, FiberNet has 23 business customers currently being served via UNEs from the Ironton physical collocation arrangement. In light of the limited number of customers currently being served as well as the associated wholesale costs incurred by Lumos for continued collocation space and the leasing of UNEs, FiberNet has made a strategic and economic decision to discontinue the provision of unbundled network element based telecommunications services to the aforementioned 23 business customers effective November 3, 2014, and to thereafter close the Ironton physical collocation arrangement, which is located in the current AT&T local exchange service territory in Ohio
8. It is FiberNet’s intention to give affected customers located in the aforementioned local exchange areas written notification via direct mail and a period of at least sixty (60) days in which to either disconnect or migrate service without penalty to an alternative telecommunications service provider serving the Ironton, Ohio

exchange area. In this regard, FiberNet customer care personnel will work closely with the affected business customers to ensure that migration to another service provider is seamless and that service is uninterrupted. A copy of the customer notification letter, which is scheduled to be mailed out to affected customers on or before August 25, 2014, is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

9. If applicable, FiberNet will return any deposits previously collected from the affected customers within thirty (30) days of their successful migration to another telecommunications service provider.
10. Despite its instant request to withdraw the continued provision of unbundled network element based telecommunications services to 23 customers currently being served out of its Ironton, Ohio physical collocation arrangement, FiberNet will continue to provide competitive telecommunications services to all other customers presently located in the State of Ohio, including potential customers in the Ironton local exchange area that can be served via a fiber based market solution, in accordance with PUCO Certificate No. 90-9201.
11. Since FiberNet is only requesting to withdraw the continued provision of unbundled network element based telecommunications service to a limited number of customers in Ironton, Ohio, and will otherwise continue to provide competitive telecommunications service to all other customers in Ohio, no changes or other modifications to its formal tariffs are necessary at this time.

WHEREFORE, for all of the reasons herein stated, FiberNet of Ohio, LLC respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio grant its Application to withdraw the provision of unbundled network element based telecommunications services to customers currently being served via a physical collocation arrangement in the Ironton, Ohio local exchange area effective November 3, 2014, and to thereafter close this physical collocation arrangement, along with such other relief as the PUCO may deem just and proper.
