Thank you for contacting the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) regarding the Greenwich Windpark, OPSB Case No. 13-0990-EL-BGN. Your comments will be docketed in the case record. It is noted that you are opposed to the proposed project.

The OPSB <u>Staff Report of Investigation</u> serves as the Staff's investigative summary of the project and serves as a recommendation to the Board. Staff's discussion of the decommissioning of the facility may be found on page 39 of the Staff Report. Conditions #46 and #47, among others, require the Applicant to perform certain duties for the decommissioning of the facility, including posting and maintaining a surety bond that would cover the costs of decommissioning the project.

Ultimately, the Board will vote whether or not to certificate the Greenwich Windpark. To date, a vote for this project has not been scheduled.
