I wrote your office on June 14, 2014 regarding the above windfarm in Greenwich, to which you replied on June 18th.

We know these turbines kill many birds daily including Eagles at times. We have an eagles nest in the section where they propose putting 2 of these 500' turbines.

We do not understand how the PUCO or the siting board can "without" further study or hearings proceed on this project. It seems like the Dept of Natural Resources or the attorney General would be interested in protecting the wildlife from these towers. If we do not protect the wildlife which are either killed or move out of the area who will?

We know from other information these farms will eventually destroy the economy rather than improve it.
