ENTRY

The Commission finds:


- (1) On March 31, 2014, Complainant, J&D Home Improvement (J&D), filed a complaint against Respondent, United Telephone Company of Ohio (CenturyLink), alleging, among other things, that Respondent charged Complainant for two PRI connections during a period when Respondent knew those connections were not in use.
- (2) On April 21, 2014, Respondent filed its answer denying most of Complainant's substantive allegations and setting forth affirmative defenses.
- (3) A settlement conference was held in this case at the Commission's offices on June 5, 2014.
- (4) On July 17, 2014, Respondent filed, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(F), a motion to dismiss this case with prejudice, on grounds that it has been settled.
- (5) Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(F) provides that, if the public utility complained against files an answer or motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response to Respondent's motion to dismiss has been filed. Accordingly, this case should be dismissed.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.


