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**tw telecom of ohio llc's REQUEST FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION  
OF NEUSTAR- POOLING ADMINISTRATOR**

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tw telecom of ohio llc ("TWTC") requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") reverse a decision of the NeuStar Pooling Administrator ("NeuStar") denying access to numbers for a TWTC customer. TWTC seeks this relief because there is a verifiable customer need for the numbers. On August 20, 2014, TWTC requested that NeuStar assign 3000 sequential direct inward dial ("DID") telephone numbers for Ascena Retail Group Inc. ("Ascena").

TWTC submitted the numbering request to NeuStar because TWTC does not have the requested 3000 sequential DID numbers that Ascena requires in the Pataskala rate center. On August 20, 2014, NeuStar denied TWTC's request for the Ascena numbers because TWTC did not meet the MTE and/or Utilization requirements for the requested block.

The FCC's rules set forth a procedure to bring the denial of a numbering resource by NeuStar to the appropriate state commission for review. The FCC's December 12, 2001 Order in its Number Resource Optimization Report and Order, CC Docket No. 99-200, FCC No. 01-362 paragraph 64- states that a carrier ". . . should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier's inability to satisfy a specific customer request. "In addition, paragraph 64 says "States may not accommodate requests for specific numbers (i.e., vanity numbers), but may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers." *Id.*

The Ascena request is consistent with paragraph 64 of the FCC order that empowers state commissions to grant customer requests seeking contiguous blocks of numbers. *Id.* Attached to this request are copies of TWTC's Thousand Block Application Form and the Months-to-Exhaust Worksheet (Attachment A), a copy of the three denials (one for each 1000 block) received from NeuStar (Attachment B), and a copy of the letter from Ascena explaining why it needed 3000 consecutive numbers for its new call center (Attachment C).

In addition, TWTC has reacted in a timely manner to the customer's needs and believes the request for Commission intervention at this point is reasonable considering the customer's projected need.

Ascena has many facilities and has currently exhausted their DID numbers. Ascena has a new data center in the Pataskala area and in order to program new numbers into their system, and keep track of their different facilities, Ascena requires a contiguous block in the 220 NPS. This will allow Ascena's various facilities to obtain the information they need.

For the reasons set forth herein, TWTC requests that the Commission expeditiously overturn the NeuStar decision to withhold the numbering resources requested by TWTC and grant the 3000 sequential DID numbers to meet its customer's needs.

#### Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia™ LERG™ Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by Telcordia™ Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification as well as the city or wire center name, rate center, rate center sub zone, homing tandem and CLLI™ tandem of the facilities based provider<sup>xi</sup>. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.

Section 1.4 Service Providers should indicate their type, e.g., local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier, interexchange carrier, CMRS. The also indicate the primary type of business in which the numbering resource is to be used. Service Providers also may indicate their preference for a particular thousands-block, e.g., 321-9XXX, or indicate any thousands-blocks that may be undesirable, e.g., 321-6XXX.

Section 1.5 Service Providers indicate the type of request. Initial requests are for first applications for thousands-blocks in a rate center, growth for additional thousands-blocks in a rate center in which the applicant already has numbering resources, and provide the required evidence as ordered by the FCC.

The thousands-block applicant certifies veracity of this form by signing their name, and providing their title and date.

Section 1.6 Service Providers must indicate the updated/current information in regards to contaminated TNs on the block they are returning to the pool. Blocks with over 10% contamination (101 TNs or more) shall not be returned to the pool unless they meet criteria outlined in section 9.1.2 of these Guidelines. If the block being returned is over 10% contaminated the PA shall seek a new block holder. If question c and/or d have a response of No, the request for return shall be denied.


