ENTRY

The Commission finds:


- (1) On June 23, 2014, Jim Snyder (Complainant) filed a complaint against The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (DEO), alleging that his service was incorrectly disconnected on December 10, 2013, without proper notice. Complainant asserted that DEO had sent letters indicating that he had until March 1, 2014, to accommodate DEO's request for access to its equipment before a potential service shutoff.
- (2) DEO filed its answer on July 14, 2014, stating that it disconnected Complainant's service because of his failure to provide DEO access to perform certain inspections. DEO denied other allegations made in the complaint.
- (3) On July 22, 2014, the attorney examiner issued an Entry scheduling an August 26, 2014 settlement conference.
- (4) On August 22, 2014, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the matter. In the motion, the parties explain that the matter has been settled and a settlement agreement has been executed.
- (5) The Commission finds that the joint motion to dismiss is reasonable and should be granted.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the joint motion to dismiss be granted. It is, further,


