## **ENTRY**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 4, 2014, Agera Energy, LLC (Applicant) filed an application to become a competitive retail electric service (CRES) provider in Ohio.
- (2) By Entry issued September 2, 2014, the application was suspended in order to give the Commission's staff additional time to consider the application.
- (3) Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-06(A)(2)(b), if the Commission acts to suspend an application, it will act to approve or deny the application within 90 days from the date that the application was suspended. On September 26, 2014, the applicant filed additional financial information; on September 29, 2014, Staff filed a recommendation that the application be approved.
- (4) Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-06(D), the Commission finds that the applicant is managerially, financially, and technically fit and capable of performing competitive retail electric service and that the applicant is managerially, financially, and technically fit and capable of complying with all applicable commission rules and orders adopted pursuant to R.C. 4928.
- (5) Accordingly, a certificate as a CRES provider should be issued to Applicant to provide competitive retail electric service in Ohio.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the application of Agera Energy, LLC be approved. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a certificate as a CRES provider be issued to Applicant to provide competitive retail electric service in Ohio. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
