The Commission finds:


- (1) On July 9, 2014, Complainant, Trevor Kershevich, filed a complaint against Respondent, AT&T Ohio (AT&T). The complaint alleges that the parties are engaged in a dispute over charges Respondent has billed Complainant for internet service.
- (2) On July 28, 2014, AT&T filed its answer denying all the allegations in the complaint and a motion to dismiss.
- (3) On September 25, 2014, the parties filed a joint request to dismiss the complaint with prejudice, stating that the parties have reached a settlement in this proceeding.
- (4) The Commission finds that the parties' joint request to dismiss this matter with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That this complaint be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record.

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.




