JAMES RUDOLPH'S REPLY TO HARDIN WIND LLC'S MEMORANDUM CONTRA TO THE PETITION TO INTERVENE

Hardin Wind, LLC's ("Hardin Wind") response to Mr. James Rudolph's Petition to Intervene demonstrates just how out of touch Hardin Wind is with the impact of the Scioto Ridge Wind Farm (the "Project") on the neighboring communities in Logan and Hardin Counties. Mr. Rudolph's lake property is not "simply too far" to be adversely impacted by the Project as Hardin Wind asserts. The turbines will be within one half mile of Indian Lake State Park. Mr. Rudolph's home is on the lake and he regularly enjoys recreating on and around the lake. Additionally, Mr. Rudolph's interests are not represented by any other party. Hardin Wind avers that the Staff will represent Mr. Rudolph's interest in this matter. Mr. Rudolph is interested in protecting his property and Indian Lake State Park. In the original certificate case, the Staff agreed to the siting of the turbines within a half mile of Indian Lake State Park. As such, Mr. Rudolph's interests and the Staff's interests are not aligned.

Rather than accept Hardin Wind's assurance that Mr. Rudolph will not be affected by the amendment, Hardin Wind should be required to present evidence at a public hearing, face cross-examination, and prove that its proposed amendment should be approved in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4906.
