ENTRY ON REHEARING

The Commission finds:

- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined under R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On September 17, 2014, the Commission issued its Finding and Order (Order) in this case. Pursuant to the Order, the Commission granted DP&L's application, as amended, to divest its generation assets.
- (3) Pursuant to R.C. 4903.10, any party who has entered an appearance in a Commission proceeding may apply for rehearing with respect to any matters determined by the Commission, within 30 days of the entry of the order upon the Commission's journal.
- (4) On October 14, 2014, the City of Miamisburg, Ohio (Miamisburg) filed an application for rehearing. On October 17, 2014 the Industrial Energy Users - Ohio (IEU-Ohio), Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC), and DP&L filed applications for rehearing. DP&L subsequently filed a memorandum contra the applications for rehearing on October 27, 2014.
- (5) The Commission finds that sufficient reason has been set forth by these parties in their applications for rehearing to warrant further consideration of the matters specified in the applications for rehearing. Accordingly, the applications for rehearing filed by these parties should be granted for further consideration of the matters specified in the applications for rehearing.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the applications for rehearing filed by Miamisburg, IEU-Ohio, OCC, and DP&L be granted for further consideration of the matters specified in the applications for rehearing. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry on Rehearing be served upon all parties of record.






