ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On July 14, 2014, Middlefield Parkway Ltd. Partnership filed a complaint against the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI or Utility) alleging that CEI had failed to install street lights and posts for Complainant's Woodsong Subdivision in the Village of Middlefield, Geauga County, Ohio, in accordance with a line extension agreement between the parties.
- (2) On August 4, 2014, CEI filed its answer, asserting that additional payment was due prior to installing streetlights in Complainant's subdivision, in accordance with CEI's Tariff Rate STL. The matter was scheduled for a settlement conference by entry issued August 13, 2014.
- (3) On October 14, 2014, the parties jointly filed a motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice as this matter has been settled.
- (4) Accordingly, this complaint should now be dismissed with prejudice at the request of the parties, and the record of this case be closed.

ORDERED, That this complaint be dismissed with prejudice, and the record of this case be closed. It is, further,
