- (1) On December 7, 2012, the Commission issued Certificate No. 04-124E(5) to Duke Energy Retail Sales, LLC (DERS) to provide aggregation and power broker services within Ohio as a competitive retail electric services (CRES) provider, with an expiration date of December 3, 2014.
- (2) On October 24, 2014, DERS filed a motion for an extension of the expiration date of its existing CRES certificate until March 3, 2015. In its memorandum in support, DERS states that its ultimate parent company, Duke Energy Corporation, has agreed to sell DERS to Dynegy, Inc. Therefore, DERS requests that its present certification be extended until the company's sale is completed and renewal of certification can be filed by the applicant's new parent corporation.
- (3) Given the pending sale of DERS, an extension of the expiration date of Certificate No. 04-124E(5) to March 3, 2015, is warranted so that DERS's customers will not be adversely affected.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That DERS's motion for an extension of the certificate expiration date be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the expiration date of Certificate No. 04-124E(5) be extended to March 3, 2015. It is, further,
