The Commission, coming now to consider the above-entitled matter, makes the following findings:

- The public hearing in this case was held on March 16, 1977.
- 2) Section 4933.25, Revised Code requires that notice of such hearing be given to the board of county commissioners of any county to be served by a waterworks company.
- 3) The Commission's Entry of March 2, 1977 failed to give notice of the March 16, 1977 public hearing of this matter to the Shelby County Board of Commissioners.
- Notice of the public hearing in this case to amend a certificate of public convenience and necessity of Arrowhead Hills Utilities Corporation, a waterworks company, so as to include Lots 201 through 273, inclusive, of the Arrowhead Hills Subdivision, Second Addition, which is situated in Shelby County, Ohio, and the Township of Washington, being a part of the north half of the southeast quarter of Section eight (8), Town seven (7), Range six (6) east, containing 75.5 acres, more or less should be given to the Shelby County Board of Commissioners.
- The Shelby County Board of Commissioners 5) should be afforded thirty (30) days from the date of this Entry in order to indicate its desire to participate in the public hearing of this matter to this Commission. If the Shelby County Board of Commissioners does not indicate its desire to participate in this public hearing in the time afforded, then this Commission should immediately proceed to its Opinion and Order in this case.
- Copies of this Entry should be served upon the applicant and the Shelby County Board of Commissioners.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That notice of the public hearing in Case No. 77-83-WW-AAC, to amend a certificate of public convenience and necessity of Arrowhead Hills Utilities Corporation, a waterworks company, so as to include Lots 201 through 273, inclusive, of the Arrowhead Hills Subdivision, Second Addition, which is situated in Shelby County, Ohio, and in the Township of Washington, being a part of the north half of the southeast quarter of Section (8), Town seven (7), Range six (6) east, containing 75.5 acres, more or less, shall be given to the Shelby County Board of Commissioners. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the Shelby County Board of Commissioners shall be afforded thirty (30) days from the date of this Entry in order to indicate its desire to participate in the public hearing of this matter to this Commission. If the Shelby County Board of Commissioners does not indicate its desire to participate in this public hearing in the time afforded, then this Commission shall immediately proceed to its Opinion and Order in this case. It is, further,

ORDERED, That copies of this Entry shall be served upon the applicant and the Shelby County Board of Commissioners.
