ENTRY NUNC PRO TUNC

The Commission, coming now to consider the above-entitled matter and its Opinion and Order of August 1, 1977, makes the following findings:

- That it has been brought to the attention of the Commission that, inadvertently, the description of Arrowhead Hills Utilities Corporation's authorized service area in the first ordering paragraph of the Commission's Opinion and Order of August 1, 1977 was in error.
- 2) That "276" should be inserted in the first ordering paragraph of the August 1, 1977 Opinion and Order where "273" appeared with reference to the lot numbers in the Arrowhead Hills Subdivision which are to be included in the applicant's authorized service area.
- 3) That the particular number as set forth in paragraph (2), above, should be inserted Nunc Pro Tunc, August 1, 1977 in the Commission's Opinion and Order of that date.
- 4) That, in all other respects, the Commission's Opinion and Order of August 1, 1977 should remain in status quo.
- 5) That copies of this Entry Nunc Pro Tunc should be served, forthwith, upon the applicant and its duly appointed attorney.
- 6) That copies of this Entry Nunc Pro Tunc should be mailed to all other interested persons.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That pursuant to the above findings the Commission's Opinion and Order of August 1, 1977 be, and is, hereby corrected Nunc Pro Tunc August 1, 1977, respectively, so that as corrected the first ordering paragraph reads as follows:

ORDERED, That the application of Arrowhead Hills Utilities Corporation to amend its existing Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be granted so that Applicant shall be authorized to serve:

A service area situated in the Township of Washington, County of Shelby, State of Ohio, commonly known as the Arrowhead Hills Subdivision, being lots 100 through 276, and legally described as: Being a part of the north half of the southeast quarter of Section Eight (8), Town Seven (7), Range Six (6) last, containing 75.5 acres more or less.

It is, further,

ORDERED, That in all other respects, the Commission's Opinion and Order of August 1, 1977 shall remain in status quo. It is, further,

ORDERED, That copies of this Entry Nunc Pro Tunc shall be served, forthwith, upon the applicant and its duly appointed attorney. It is, further,

ORDERED, That copies of this Entry Nunc Pro Tunc shall be mailed to all other interested persons.
