FINDING AND ORDER


- (1) The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (DEO) is a public utility and a natural gas company as defined in R.C. 4905.02 and 4905.03 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On November 14, 2014, DEO filed an application for approval of its revised bill format, in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-13-11(D). DEO explains that the revised bill format is intended to more clearly identify when a balance due is transferred from one account to another. An example of the current bill format is appended as Attachment A to the application, and an example of the revised bill format, as proposed, is appended as Attachment B to the application.
- (3) Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-13-11(D) provides that, if the Commission does not act upon an application for a new bill format within 45 days, the proposed bill format shall be automatically approved. The 45-day time period for this application ends December 29, 2014.
- (4) In its application, DEO requests that the Commission approve this application as soon as possible, to enable DEO time to make the programming changes necessary to implement the new bill format.
- (5) No party filed any comment or raised any substantive issue regarding DEO's application.
- (6) The Commission has reviewed DEO's proposed bill format and finds it to be clear and understandable; therefore, we find that DEO's application should be approved.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That DEO's application for approval of its revised bill format, as filed on November 14, 2014, be approved. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Finding and Order be served upon all parties in this proceeding.
