PETITION OF CINCINNATI BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY LLC FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION OF THE POOLING ADMINISTRATOR

Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company LLC ("CBT") hereby requests that the

Commission review and overturn a decision of the number Pooling Administrator ("PA")

which denied a CBT request for numbering resources. On December 17, 2014, CBT

filed a request with the PA for an NXX in the Cincinnati rate center to establish a

Location Routing Number ("LRN") for a new switch that it is deploying. CBT's request

was denied on the grounds that CBT has not satisfied the utilization level and months-toexhaust ("MTE") criteria established by the Federal Communications Commission and
outlined in the Central Office Code Assignment Guidelines ("COCAG"). Under the
federal numbering rules, a state commission may overturn the PA's decision based on its
determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for the numbering
resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. For the reasons set forth
below, CBT submits that the Commission is justified in overturning the PA's decision
and granting CBT's request for a new NXX to establish an LRN for its new switch.

The new switch will provide CBT the ability to offer innovative new services not possible with its existing circuit switches. Moreover, it will enable CBT to relieve overcrowding on existing switches and allow CBT to operate its network more efficiently. However, before CBT can begin using this new switch, it must have an LRN assigned to the switch. In order to accommodate number portability and number pooling a unique LRN must be assigned for each switch within a LATA.³

Due to the specific requirements for LRN assignment,⁴ none of CBT's existing numbers can be used as an LRN. Upon receipt of the new NXX, CBT will keep the "0" thousand-block and return the remaining blocks to the number pool. CBT will be able to port numbers from its existing numbering resources to the new switch once an LRN is assigned for the switch, so it does not anticipate the need for additional numbering resources for this switch beyond this initial request.

When CBT filed an application with the PA for an NXX to establish an LRN for this switch, the application was denied because CBT does not satisfy the utilization and MTE criteria for receipt of growth numbering resources. To further assist the Commission's review, a copy of CBT's application submitted to the PA via the automated Pooling Administration System ("PAS") is attached. This documentation includes the Part 1A application, the Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet, and the Pooling Administration System response denying the request because the Utilization Threshold has not been met.

For the reasons set forth above, CBT requests that the Commission overturn the PA's decision and direct the PA to grant CBT's request for a new NXX in the Cincinnati rate center to establish an LRN so that CBT can proceed with deployment of its new switch.




