ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On November 21, 2014, The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) filed an application for approval of a revised bill format for electric service and for approval of certain accounting authority.
- (2) Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-10-22(C) and 4901:1-10-33(F), if the Commission does not act upon the application within forty-five calendar days, the new bill format shall be deemed approved on the forty-sixth day after the filing.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that additional information and investigation is necessary to thoroughly review the application filed by DP&L. Therefore, good cause exists to suspend the 45-day automatic approval process for DP&L's application for approval of a revised bill format, in order for the Commission and its staff to further review this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the application for approval of a revised bill format for electric service be suspended in accordance with finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
