4 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Let's go on the
 5 record. The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio
 6 calls at this time and place Case No. 14-117-EL-FAC,
 7 being in the Matter of the Application of the Dayton
 8 Power and Light Company to Establish a Fuel Rider.

9 My name is Megan Addison and with me is
 10 Bryce McKenney and we are the attorneys assigned to
 11 this case. Let's go ahead and begin by taking
 12 appearances starting with the company.

13 MR. GRIFFIN: Yes. I'm Randall V.
 14 Griffin, in-house counsel for the Dayton Power and
 15 Light Company. My address and phone number are on a
 16 business card that I provided to the court reporter.

17 MR. BEELER: Thank you, your Honor. On
 18 behalf of the staff of the Public Utilities
 19 Commission of Ohio, Steve Beeler and Thomas McNamee,
 20 Assistant Attorneys General of the Office of the Ohio
 21 Attorney General Mike DeWine, 180 East Broad Street,
 22 Columbus, Ohio 43215.

23 MS. KERN: On behalf of the Office of the
 24 Ohio Consumers' Counsel, Bruce J. Weston, I am Kyle
 25 Kern, Assistant Consumers' Counsel, 10 West Broad

1 Street, Suite 1800, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

2 LAW CLERK ADDISON: All right. Thank you
3 all.

4 I believe there's one pending motion in
5 this case, a motion to intervene filed by the Ohio
6 Consumers' Counsel on March 10, 2014. At this time
7 we will go ahead and grant that motion.

8 MS. KERN: Thank you, your Honor.

9 LAW CLERK ADDISON: I also believe there
10 is a stipulation filed in this case; is that correct?

11 MR. GRIFFIN: That is correct and I --
12 it's been prefiled and I apologize. I did not bring
13 extra copies of it. It was prefiled. It's titled
14 "Stipulation and Recommendation," and I would request
15 that it be marked into evidence as Joint Exhibit 1.
16 And I would move it into evidence.

17 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Any objections?

18 HEARING EXAMINER MCKINNEY: We'll mark it
19 at this time.

20 (EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)

21 LAW CLERK ADDISON: So marked and
22 admitted into evidence.

23 (EXHIBIT ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.)

24 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Do you have anything
25 else?

1 MR. GRIFFIN: Nothing in a preliminary
2 way. I believe staff has a couple of exhibits that
3 they would like marked and moved into evidence as
4 well, and then we'll put Ms. Kellie on the stand.

5 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Mr. Beeler.

6 MR. BEELER: Thank you, your Honor. The
7 staff would move for -- to mark as Staff Exhibit 1
8 the public version of the audit report filed in
9 the -- prefiled in the docket on August 21, 2014.
10 And the staff would also like marked as Staff Exhibit
11 1A the confidential version of that same audit report
12 filed in the docket on August 21, 2014.

13 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Okay. They will be
14 so marked.

15 (EXHIBITS MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)

16 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Any objection to the
17 admission?

18 MR. GRIFFIN: The company would have no
19 objection to its admission. We would note because
20 there is a stipulation we will not be going into
21 details in that audit report, and the company does
22 not necessarily agree with every word of it, but we
23 have no objections to it being admitted into
24 evidence.

25 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Thank you.

1 MS. KERN: No objections.

2 MR. BEELER: Just move for the admission
3 of those documents. That's all.

4 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Those documents will
5 be so marked and admitted into evidence.

6 (EXHIBITS ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.)

7 HEARING EXAMINER MCKINNEY: And the
8 company's statement will be noted.

9 MR. GRIFFIN: Thank you. And at this
10 point I would like to call Jessica Kellie to the
11 stand.

12 (Witness sworn.)

13 HEARING EXAMINER MCKINNEY: Please be
14 seated. Please state your name and address for the
15 record.

16 THE WITNESS: Jessica Kellie, business
17 address is 1065 Woodman Drive, Dayton, Ohio 45432.

18 MR. GRIFFIN: Thank you.

19 And, your Honor, Ms. Kellie's had some
20 prefiled testimony with respect to the stipulation.
21 I would request that it be marked as Company Exhibit
22 1.

23 LAW CLERK ADDISON: So marked.

24 (EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)

1 JESSICA E. KELLIE

2 being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was
3 examined and testified as follows:

4 DIRECT EXAMINATION

5 By Mr. Griffin:

6 Q. Ms. Kellie, welcome to the Commission.
7 You reviewed for this proceeding your prefiled
8 testimony?

9 A. Yes.

10 Q. Do you have any changes or modifications
11 to make to that testimony?

12 A. No, I do not.

13 Q. And do you under oath hereby adopt that
14 testimony as your own?

15 A. Yes.

16 Q. Could you very -- my understanding is, am
17 I correct, that the testimony does summarize the
18 major elements of the stipulation?

19 A. Yes.

20 Q. Could you state for the record your --
21 your final conclusions and recommendations with
22 respect to the stipulation in conjunction with the
23 issues in this case.

24 A. I recommend that the Commission approve
25 the stipulation which complies with the regulatory

1 criteria in its entirety without modification.

2 MR. GRIFFIN: Thank you.

3 And with that Ms. Kellie is available for
4 cross-examination.

5 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Mr. Beeler?

6 MR. BEELER: No questions, your Honor.

7 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Ms. Kern?

8 MS. KERN: No questions, your Honor.

9 LAW CLERK ADDISON: I have a question,
10 Ms. Kellie. Can you describe the benefits of the
11 stipulation to the public interest just for the
12 record.

13 THE WITNESS: Yes. The stipulation
14 addresses the recommendations contained in the audit
15 report. Among other benefits the stipulation
16 provides a credit to both the fuel and AER rider.

17 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Thank you,
18 Ms. Kellie.

19 Do you have any questions?

20 HEARING EXAMINER MCKINNEY: I do not.

21 Thank you, Ms. Kellie.

22 MR. GRIFFIN: Thank you. I would move
23 Ms. Kellie's prefiled testimony into evidence at this
24 time.

25 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Any objections?

1 MS. KERN: No objections.

2 MR. BEELER: No objections.

3 LAW CLERK ADDISON: It will be so
4 admitted into evidence.

5 (EXHIBIT ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.)

6 MR. GRIFFIN: That concludes the
7 company's presentation.

8 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Thank you.

9 Mr. Beeler?

10 MR. BEELER: Nothing, your Honor.

11 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Ms. Kern?

12 MS. KERN: No, nothing further.

13 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Okay. And there is
14 no other pending matters that we need to address
15 today?

16 MR. GRIFFIN: No, ma'am.

17 LAW CLERK ADDISON: Seeing none, we are
18 adjourned.
