Clean Energy Future-Lordstown, LLC Schedules January 13, 2015 Public Meeting to Outline Plans for a 800 Megawatt Gas Fired Generation Plant To Be Built in Lordstown, Ohio


Clean Energy Future-Lordstown, LLC invites residents of Lordstown, Ohio and other interested members of the public, to attend a public informational meeting regarding company plans to build an 800 megawatt (MW) gas fired, combined cycle power station.

The electric generating facility will be located on an industrially zoned site within the Lordstown Industrial Park, located off Route 45, with close proximity to I-80/I-76.

The project will consist of two gas fired, high efficiency combustion turbines with two heat recovery steam generators and a single steam turbine. It will have a cooling tower and state of the art environmental controls. The plant will be served by natural gas from one or multiple pipelines. The generating station will be interconnected to the proximate 345 kV transmission corridor (Highland-Mansfield; and Highland-Sammis circuits), about 0.5-mile from the generating facility. Water and wastewater services will be supplied by the City of Warren and the Meander Water District. Construction of the project is estimated to begin in fall 2015, with projected commercial operation to begin in mid-2018.

This facility will fill a need caused by the retirement in the next several years of several coal fired generating stations in northeastern Ohio that will reduce the regional electricity capacity.

The public meeting will take place from 5:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., on January 13, 2015 at the Village of Lordstown Administration Center, Community Room, 1455 Salt Springs Road, Lordstown, Ohio 44481. Company representatives will present stations throughout the room with each having information about the various aspects of the project, and they will be available to respond to inquiries from those attending.
