

<u>Name of Project:</u> Juniper-Jennings (Q-15) & Juniper-Newburgh 138 kV Transmission Line Underground Reconductor Project ("Project").

4906-11-02 (B) (2) (a): Brief Description of the Project

In this Project, American Transmission Systems, Incorporated ("ASTP"), a FirstEnergy company, is proposing to reconductor the underground section of the Juniper-Jennings (Q-15) & the Juniper-Newburgh (Q-18) 138 kV Transmission Lines. The proposed section of the Juniper-Jennings (Q-15) & the Juniper-Newburgh (Q-18) 138 kV Transmission Lines to be reconductored is located between structures #2533 and #2534 in the City of Independence, and the Village of Valley View, Cuyahoga County, Ohio and runs for approximately 1400 feet. The existing conductor is 2500 kcmil aluminum conductor with XLPE insulation and the Project proposes to replace it with 2500 kcmil copper conductor with XLPE insulation.

The general location of the Project is shown in Exhibit 1, which is a partial copy of the United States Geologic Survey, Cuyahoga County Ohio, Quad Map, ID number 41081-D6. The general layout in Exhibit 2. The Project is located in the City of Independence, and the Village of Valley View, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

4906-11-02 (B) (2) (b): Construction Notice Requirements

The Project meets the requirements for a Construction Notice because the Project is within the types of projects defined by Item (3) of the Interim Application Requirement Matrix for Electric Power Transmission Lines in the Finding and Order issued on September 4, 2012, as subsequently modified on December 17, 2012, in Case No. 12-1981-GE-BRO which modified Appendix A of Rule 4906-1-01 of the Ohio Administrative Code. This item states:

(3) Replacing conductors on existing structures with larger or bundled conductors.

The proposed Project involves replacement of 2500 kcmil aluminum conductor with 2500 kcmil copper conductor, which are physically the same size, but the copper has a larger capacity. The Project will use existing right-of-way and no new right-of-way will be required.

4906-11-02 (B) (3): Need For the Project

The existing conductor is being replaced due to the condition of the existing conductor as a result of previous failures of the terminators, which connect the overhead and underground conductors. In order to meet current design requirements, support future demand, provided for a system spare conductor, and increase the reliability of the lines, it was decided to change the type of cable (aluminum to copper) and upgrade capacity of the new conductors with a 2500 kcmil copper conductor during the replacement.

<u>4609-11-02 (B) (4): Construction Schedule</u>

The construction schedule for this Project is expected to begin as early as March 9, 2015 and completed by June 30, 2015.

<u>4609-11-02 (B) (7): Area Map</u>

Exhibit 1 depicts the general location of the Project. This Exhibit provides a partial copy of the United States Geological Survey, Cuyahoga County Ohio, quadrangle map (Quad Order ID 41081-D6). To locate and view the Project site from Columbus Ohio, take I-71 N for approximately 112 miles. Take exit 220 for I-271 N toward Erie Pa for 0.3 miles, and then continue onto I-271 for 9.6 miles. Take exit 10 and merge on to I-77 N toward Cleveland for 12.1 miles. Then take exit 155 for Rockside Road toward Seven Hills-Independence for 0.3 miles and turn right onto Rockside Road for 1.3 miles. Turn left onto Canal Road for 0.7 miles and then take the second left across the bridge for 171 feet and then turn right onto W Canal Road for 0.3 miles. Take the second left onto Exchange Road for 0.2 miles. The end of Exchange Road is the address 7700 Exchange Road which contains a gravel lot. Drive 250 feet west and then 310 feet to the south to reach the southwest corner of the gravel lot where southernmost structure #2533 of the Project is located.

To locate the northernmost structure #2534 of the Project, start from the intersection of W Canal Road and Exchange Road go north on W Canal Road for 0.4 miles and then turn right onto Cloverleaf Parkway for 250 ft. Turn left at the driveway to 5520 Cloverleaf Parkway for 340 feet to the west. Then turn left, behind the warehouse at 5520 Cloverleaf Parkway and head south for 140 feet until the end of the pavement. A gravel access road begins there, follow it 200 feet south to loeate structure #2534. An alternative access point for the gravel access road is at 7601 Exchange Street from a parking lot that can be accessed from either W Canal Road or Exchange Street. The gravel access road is located in the northeast corner of the parking lot near the W Canal Road entrance. From there follow the gravel road for 1700 feet to locate structure #2534.
