ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 16, 2014, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) filed the instant application requesting approval of tariff language regarding customer energy usage data (CEUD). Duke explains this application is being filed pursuant to the Commission's May 26, 2014 Entry on Rehearing in *In re Commission's Investigation of Ohio's Retail Elec. Service Market*, which required Duke to submit an amended tariff specifying the terms, conditions, and charges associated with providing interval CEUD. In this application, Duke proposes to amend its tariff to provide details related to exactly what certified retail electric service (CRES) providers may request, how such data will be provided, and at what cost.
- (2) In order to accomplish the review of Duke's application, the attorney examiner finds that the following procedural schedule should be established:
 - (a) March 6, 2015 - Deadline for the filing of motions to intervene.
 - (b) March 6, 2015 - Deadline for the filing of comments on the application.
 - (c) March 27, 2015 - Deadline for all parties to file reply comments.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the procedural schedule set forth in finding (2) be observed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be sent to the Electric-Energy industry service lists. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon Duke, all CRES providers, and all interested persons of record in this case.
