In response to North Coast Gas Transmission's correspondence regarding the Informational Meeting for the public on January 20, 2015, I would submit that NCGT presented a display of poster boards and not an informational meeting.

The preferred definition of meeting is a gathering of people for a particular purpose (such as to talk about business). The landowners expected a discussion of the NCGT pipeline. The poster boards display did not meet the definition of a meeting but was similar to a trade fair or science fair.

NCGT did not respond to agenda requests or to questions submitted by the landowners.

Their correspondence that an informational meeting was held is inaccurate and misleading.
