There is no way that I would consider the event held on 1/20/2015 to be a "public meeting". It was more of an open house with little to no contact between stakeholders and North Coast or WE Realty. In fact, most of the representatives from these companies were not wearing any kind of identification. We had no idea who was who, no one was in charge. There was no formal presentation to the group, no opportunity to ask questions and hear answers as a group, and no new information was presented. When we tried to ask specific questions, no one was able to or wanted to give answers. Questions submitted in writing to North Coast prior to the meeting were not addressed. The event to me, was just another example of how this whole project has been handled in an underhanded, shady way. We were not informed that our property was definitely being affected until New Year's eve 2014 and the siting board approved the thing on 1/6/2015. I even heard other people at this event state that they STILL had NOT received notice at the time of the meeting. It is clear to me that North Coast has no interest in being upfront with stakeholders and sharing information.

Thank you for contacting the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio and the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) regarding the Oregon Lateral Pipeline project. I will docket your concerns in case number 14-1754-GA-BLN.

I'm sorry to learn that you were disappointed by the format of North Coast's public information meeting held last month. Additionally, you have concerns with landowner notification, project timeline, and the psi at which the pipeline would be operated. I have shared these concerns with Mike Calderone, President and CEO of North Coast, and would encourage you to contact him directly at (614) 505-7418. He is anticipating your call. Condition number 27 of the OPSB *Staff Report of Investigation* requires North Coast to be open and responsive to the concerns of affected landowners.
