ENTRY NUNC PRO TUNC

The Commission finds:


- (1) Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy) are public utilities as defined in R.C. 4905.02, and, as such are subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) In a Finding and Order issued January 28, 2015, in this matter, the Commission approved an interim update filed by FirstEnergy, seeking to update rates effective February 1, 2015 through June 30, 2015, relating to its Non-Market-Based Services Rider (NMB Rider).
- (3) The Commission inadvertently stated that the new tariffs to be filed by FirstEnergy would be effective for bills rendered, rather than services rendered. Therefore, the third ordering paragraph of the January 28, 2015, Finding and Order is modified nunc pro tunc to read "ORDERED, That the effective date of the new tariffs shall be a date not earlier than the first day of the February 2015 billing cycle, and the date upon which two complete printed copies of FirstEnergy's final tariffs are filed with the Commission. The new tariffs shall be effective for services rendered on or after February 1, 2015."
- (4) In all other respects, the January 28, 2015, Finding and Order remains unchanged.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the January 28, 2015, Finding and Order be modified, nunc pro tunc, in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,
