The Applicant is a Pennsylvania domestic limited liability company that is registered to do business in Ohio and Maryland. David Mikula and Erich Landis are officers, members and directly own the Applicant. In addition to Applicant's license in Ohio, Applicant is licensed in Pennsylvania to supply electric generation supply services as a broker/marketer, and has applied for a license in Maryland to supply electric generation services as a broker. Applicant's application is currently pending with the Maryland Public Service Commission. Applicant does not have any affiliates or subsidiary companies that supply retail or wholesale electricity or natural gas to customers and companies that aggregate customers in North America.

Applicant's two members, Dave Mikula and Erich Landis, have a combined experience of over twenty-five years in the electricity and natural gas industry. In addition to Applicant's Ohio license to provide aggregation and power broker services, Applicant is also currently licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to offer, render, furnish or supply electric generation supplier services as a "broker/marketer" to various customer types throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Applicant has also recently applied for a license in Maryland to supply electric generation services as a broker, and said application is currently pending.

Applicant will use its experience and existing infrastructure to work in its preferred business segments to build new relationships and leverage existing relationships into new business in the territories in which it holds licenses to provide services.

Although serving residential customers is not a focus of the Applicant's business, it does serve 117 residential customers in Ohio who are primarily friends, family members or employees of existing commercial customers.

The Applicant does not provide billing statements to its customers. All billing is performed by the supplier, which also provides the customer with a written agreement for the contracted service. The Applicant has always timely responded to customer inquiries and any complaints, and will continue to do so.
