ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Liberty Transportation Inc. (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On November 14, 2014, Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) A prehearing conference was held on December 18, 2014; however the parties were unable to settle the matter. Thereafter, a hearing was scheduled for February 19, 2015.
- (4) On February 9, 2015, a joint motion was filed requesting to continue the hearing. Respondent states a scheduling conflict arose that would prevent attendance at the hearing. Staff is in agreement with the continuance.
- (5) Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-13 provides that a continuance of hearings may be granted upon motion of any party for good cause shown.
- (6) The attorney examiner finds good cause to grant the motion to continue the hearing. Accordingly, the February 19, 2015 hearing should be continued until February 26, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion to continue the hearing be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That this case be scheduled for hearing in accordance with finding (6).  
It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
