ENTRY

The Commission finds:


- (1) On September 4, 2014, Complainants, JML Property Management, LLC (JML), and Ernest and Nadine Pasquot, filed a complaint against Respondent, The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) alleging, among other things, that bills for electric service at a particular DP&L service address managed by JML, increased abnormally before the meter there was replaced.
- (2) DP&L filed its answer on September 19, 2014.
- (3) A settlement conference was held at the Commission's offices on November 13, 2014.
- (4) On February 4, 2015, Complainants filed a motion to dismiss this complaint with prejudice, stating that the parties have reached a settlement in this proceeding.
- (5) The Commission finds that Complainants' motion to dismiss this matter with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That Complainants' motion be granted, and this complaint be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.


