The Commission finds:

- (1) On September 26, 2014, Complainant, Donald Rhodes, filed a complaint against Respondent, Ohio Power Company d/b/a AEP Ohio (AEP Ohio), alleging both that Complainant was overcharged for electric service and that Respondent changed his electric meter without cause.
- (2) Respondent filed its answer on October 16, 2014.
- (3) A settlement conference occurred, as scheduled, on January 7, 2015.
- (4) On January 12, 2015, Respondent filed, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(F), a motion to dismiss this case with prejudice, on grounds that it has been settled.
- (5) Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(F) provides that, if the public utility complained against files an answer or motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response to AEP Ohio's motion to dismiss has been filed.
- (6) Accordingly, the Commission finds that Respondent's motion should be granted and this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Respondent's motion be granted, and this case be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,
