The Commission should deny Cavalier/Windstream's Motion to Dismiss because the central premise of the Motion -- that NEON Health Services is not represented by counsel -- is not accurate. On or about March 11, 2015, undersigned counsel, NEON Health Services' long-time counsel, entered an appearance with the Commission. See attached Exhibit A.

In a letter dated February 12, 2015, Mr. Willie F. Austin, President and Chief Executive Officer of NEON Health Services, asked the Commission to investigate this matter. Cavalier/Windstream claims that NEON Health Services owes it \$33,898.37, but it can't provide or produce a contract. NEON Health Services terminated the contract, but Cavalier/Windstream disputes the cancellation. It is obvious that NEON Health Services cancelled the contract because Cavalier/Windstream reported/transferred the lines to NEON Health Services' new vendor -- something that could not occur without a valid cancellation of any Cavalier/Windstream contract. Plus, Cavalier/Windstream overbilled NEON Health Services in the amount of \$148,727.23 -well after NEON Health Services cancelled the contract.

To say, as Cavalier/Windstream does, that the Commission should not investigate this matter because Mr. Austin's letter of inquiry to the Commission constitutes the practice of law is uncomfortably disingenuous. The cases cited by Cavalier/Windstream deal with non-lawyers appearing in court or administrative proceedings, making oral arguments, examining and cross-examining witnesses, compromising claims, offering proof, and the like. No such unauthorized practice of law has taken place -- or will take place -- here. NEON Health Services has counsel who has entered an appearance. The Supreme Court of Ohio has admonished Ohio tribunals to resolve disputes on their merits -- not through "gotcha" hyper-technicalities. Perotti v. Ferguson, 7 Ohio St.3d 1 (1983). Regrettably, it appears that Cavalier/Windstream does not want the Commission to resolve this dispute on the merits.

NEON Health Services is a non-profit community health center which has been serving the medically underserved of Cuyahoga County for forty-seven (47) years -- without regard to

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a patient's ability to pay. Because NEON Health Services is treating more and more patients who lack health insurance, it must make each dollar stretch farther and farther. Shouldn't NEON Health Services have the right to ask the Commission to look into this telecommunications equipment and service/billing matter on the merits? After all, an opportunity to be heard is a fundamental tenet of due process. <u>Mullane v. Central Hanover</u> <u>Bank & Trust Co.</u>, 339 U.S. 306 (1950). In the interest of fair play and justice, NEON Health Services urges the Commission to deny the Motion to Dismiss and to investigate this matter and resolve it on the merits.
