MOTION FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to recently effective Rule 4901:1-24-09(B) of the Ohio Administrative Code, Consolidated Edison Solutions, Inc. ("ConEd Solutions") seeks an extension of Certificate No. 13-668E(1) which was issued in Case No. 13-557-EL-CRS. The expiration date of Certificate No. 13-668E(1) is March 31, 2015. Due to the fact that adverse weather conditions delayed the travel plans of the persons who prepared the renewal application, ConEd Solutions was not able to file its renewal application on time. It has now filed its renewal application on March 13, 2015 which is no later than the March 31, 2015 expiration date of its current certificate. ConEd Solutions respectfully requests that Certificate No. 13-668E(1) be automatically extended from March 31, 2015 until April 13, 2015 or until the date that the new certificate is issued.

WHEREFORE, Consolidated Edison Solutions, Inc. respectfully requests that Certificate No. 13-668E(1) be automatically extended to April 13, 2015 or until a new certificate is issued and authorize it to continue to operate during the pendency of the renewal application certification review, so that there will be no interruption in service to customers.



ConEd Solutions sincerely apologizes for the delay and assures the Commission that it will timely file renewal applications in the future. ConEd Solutions emphasizes its desire to continue to serve customers in Ohio.

Recently effective Rule 4901:1-24-09(B) provides that a motion requesting an extension of a certificate will be deemed automatically approved (unless ruled otherwise by the Commission or an Attorney Examiner within three business days), if a renewal application is filed fewer than thirty calendar days prior to the expiration date of the certificate but no later than the expiration date. ConEd Solutions submits that it has met the criteria and respectfully requests an automatic extension of the expiration date of Certificate No. 13-668E(1) issued in Case No. 13-557-EL-CRS to April 13, 2015 or until such time as a new certificate is issued so as not to interrupt service to customers.
