ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 9, 2010, Richard Carano (Applicant) filed an application for certification of a roof-mounted solar photovoltaic system located at the Village Pharmacy in New Middletown, Ohio, as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, as defined by R.C. 4928.01(A)(37). On October 13, 2010, Certificate No. 10-SPV-OH-GATS-0479 was issued to Richard Carano pursuant to the 60-day automatic approval process set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), with an effective date of October 9, 2010.
- (2) On November 17, 2014, the Applicant filed a request to decertify the facility. The Applicant states that it wishes to decertify the facility, which is registered under the certificate number 10-SPV-OH-GATS-0479 in this case.
- (3) The Commission finds that the Applicant's request is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the Commission finds that Certificate No. 10-SPV-OH-GATS-0479 should be revoked and this case dismissed and closed of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Certificate No. 10-SPV-OH-GATS-0479 be revoked and this case dismissed and closed of record, in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
