ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 3, 2015, Complainant, Jason E. Brown, filed a complaint against Respondent, Aqua Ohio, Inc. (Aqua), alleging that Complainant suffered damages resulting from Respondent's installation of water service meters at his residence.
- (2) On March 23, 2015, Aqua filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file its responsive pleading in this case. Aqua asserts that it needs additional time to investigate the complaint before it can complete its responsive pleading and, on that basis, requests that it be granted an extension, until March 27, 2015, to file its responsive pleading in this case.
- (3) Upon review of the record, the attorney examiner finds that Respondent's motion for extension of time is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, Aqua shall have until the close of business on March 27, 2015, to file its answer or other responsive pleading in this case.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Aqua's motion for extension of time be granted, and that Aqua's answer be filed no later than the close of business on March 27, 2015. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
