**STATEMENT OF DUKE ENERGY OHIO, INC.,
THAT THERE ARE NO OUTSTANDING ISSUES**

On February 24, 2015, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Company), filed an application in the above-captioned proceedings, asking for approval of an adjustment of the rates being charged under its Accelerated Main Replacement Program (AMRP) Rider. A procedural schedule was issued by Attorney Examiner Entry, dated March 4, 2015 (Entry), establishing March 24, 2015, as the deadline for comments and intervention. The Entry also required the Company to file a statement, by March 27, 2015, informing the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Commission) whether all issues raised in parties' comments have been resolved. The Company hereby files such statement.


On March 23, 2015, Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its comments and recommendations. No motions to intervene have been filed in these proceedings and the deadline for such intervention has passed. Therefore, the only issues raised are those that were encompassed in Staff's comments.

Staff indicated that it had identified two exceptions to the Company's proposed revenue requirement, both related to employee meal expenses. The proposed reductions of the revenue requirement total \$637.64. Without addressing the substance of the proposed disallowances, the

Company agrees to reduce the total revenue requirement as recommended by Staff. The Company also agrees with Staff that such reduction will have no impact on the AMRP rates proposed in the Application.

Because no issues remain to be resolved and no stipulation is needed, the Company believes that a hearing in this case is unnecessary under the instructions of the Entry. Therefore, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Application, as filed, with the exception of reducing the total revenue requirement to \$27,804,666.20.


