ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Each of the above-captioned applications was filed in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F) for certification as an Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility as defined in R.C. 4928.01.
- (2) In addition, Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F)(2) provides for automatic approval of an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, unless the Commission suspends the application within 60 days.
- (3) On April 6, 2015, Staff contacted the attorney examiner to request that each of the above-captioned applications be suspended, because the applicants have not responded to repeated inquiries by Staff for additional information.
- (4) Given the failure of each applicant to provide the additional information that Staff has requested, the attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process with respect to each application.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for each captioned application be suspended. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record in these cases.
